Assembly Precautions

- 1. Assemble only according to these instructions. Improper assembly can create hazards.

- 5. Do not assemble or use this device when tired or when under the influence of drugs or medication.
- 6. Weight capacity and other product capabilities apply to properly and completely assembled product only.


User Precautions


- 1. This Floor Bumper Storage Stand is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with or near this Floor Bumper Storage Stand .
- 2. Use as intended only.
- 3. Inspect before every use; do not use if parts are loose, damaged or missing.
- 4. Do not exceed listed weight capacity, evenly distributed. Be aware of dynamic loading. Sudden load movement may briefly create excess load causing product failure.
- 5. Use only on flat, level, hard surface able to properly support your painting tools and accessories.


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


NOTE: Leave ALL nuts and bolts hand tight until everything is together, and aligned. Refer to page 4 of this manual for hardware detail diagram.


- 1) Attach Lower Vertical Bar (6) to Base Bar (7) using bolts, washers and nuts (10, 11 & 12) as shown in Figure 1
- 2) Attach Lower Vertical Bar (5) to Base Bar (7) as in step 1, using bolts, washers and nuts (10, 11 & 12) as shown in Figure 1
- 3) Attach Bottom Connecting Bar (3) to the above assemblies as shown in Figures 1 & 2
- 4) Attach Casters (13) to each corner of Lower Frame Assembly as shown in Figures 3 & 4 with the Locking Washer and Nut shown in the hardware detail diagram. It is recommended to place one the locking casters on the same side, and the side that will be easiest to access when the Bumper Rack is in use.
- 5) Using bolts, washers and nuts (10, 11 & 12), attach Middle Connecting Bar (2) to the tops of Lower Vertical Bars (5) and (6) from the Lower Frame Assembly above, as shown in Figure 5
- 6) Attach Upper Vertical Bar (4) to the top of above assembly using bolts, washers and nuts (10, 11 & 12), as shown in Figure 5
- 7) Using bolts, washers and nuts (10, 11 & 12), attach Top Connecting Bar (1) to the above assembly, as shown in Figure 6
- 8) Slide the pins for the Long Support Bars (8) and for the Short Support Bars (9) into the frame of your Bumper Stand to suit your needs, as shown in Figures 6 & 7. Be mindful of the weight that will be on these Support Bars and be careful not to overload them. Damage to the bumpers and to the user could occur. These supports can be easily moved and reconfligured at any time.
- 9) Your ATD-6576 is ready to use.












