FALL HAZARD


- Awkward, out of balance body positions may be attempted while trying to reach specific areas of objects placed on the Tear Down Table during use. Failure to ensure proper footing can quickly result in a fall which could inflict serious personal injury or property damage.
- This Tear Down Table is designed for use in dismantling mechanical components only.
- **DO NOT** concentrate a heavy load to any corner or edge of the Tear Down Table. This can cause the balance to shift suddenly, tipping the Tear Down Table forward.
- DO NOT exceed the rated 1000 lbs. [454 kg] weight capacity.
- DO NOT use as a seat.
- DO NOT stand on the Tear Down Table.
- **DO NOT** use the top of the Tear Down Table as a storage surface.



PINCH HAZARD

• This Tear Down Table has moveable components that can crush and pinch. Keep fingers and hands away from pinch points when operating.

UNPACKING

Remove the parts and accessories from the packaging and inspect for damage and missing parts. In the event there are damaged or missing parts, contact your point of sale immediately.

WARNING: Do not use this Tear Down Table if any part is missing of damaged. Replace the missing or damaged part before using. Failure to do so could result in personal injury.

ASSEMBLY

- 1) Begin by placing the table top [7] upside down on a soft, smooth surface.
- 2) Attach the four legs (#10) to the Tear Down Table with the bolts (#3), flat washers (#5) and spring washers (#4). **NOTE: FINGER TIGHTEN DO NOT TIGHTEN ALL THE WAY AT THIS POINT**
- 3) Attach the shelf (#8) to the legs (#10) with the bolts (#1) and nuts (#2) NOTE: FINGER TIGHTEN DO NOT TIGHTEN ALL THE WAY AT THIS POINT
- 4) Insert casters (#6) into all four legs.
- 5) Set the Tear Down Table upright and ensure that it's level, then tighten all the hardware with a wrench.
- 6) Slide the drawer (#11) into drawer slot on the right side of the Tear Down Table top. The drawer comes with two keys. Check that the lock works correctly.
- 7) Slide the plastic oil receiver tray (#9) into the slot on the left side of the Tear Down Table top.


CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Maintain your Tear Down Table with care. This Tear Down Table and drawer are finished in rugged powder coating which will provide many years of service, however it is advisable to keep the finish clean and free from excessive dust and dirt.

- Keep the Tear Down Table in a clean and dry environment. **DO NOT** store it in or expose it to a damp or wet environment.
- Occasionally inspect all components for potential damage and proper alignment. Check all hardware for tightness.
- **DO NOT** use if damage is discovered.
- **DO NOT** place heavy components on one extreme corner or edge of the Tear Down Table. This can cause the balance to shift suddenly, tipping the Tear Down Table.
- Store the Tear Down Table on a flat, level surface only, to prevent possible unattended rolling and property damage.
- · Always remove and empty the drain pan after each use to avoid hazardous material spills.
- Periodically clean drawer of accumulated grease or other debris.
