- Lift only on areas of the vehicle as specified by the vehicle manufacturer.
- No alterations shall be made to this product.
- This jack should be used as an emergency device only.

A SETUP

- Prior to each use, visual inspection (See Pg. 3) shall be made to the device by checking for abnormal conditions, such as cracked welds, leaks, and damaged, loose, or missing parts.
- Consult the vehicle owner's manual to determine the location of lift points.
- Activate hazard warning flashers and turn off the vehicle.
- Be sure to set the vehicle in park with the emergency brake on and wheels securely chocked in both directions.
- Be sure that the vehicle and the jack are on a hard, level surface.
- Follow the tire-changing procedures or tire-chain mounting procedures specified in the vehicle manufacturer's owner's manual.

ASSEMBLY

• Attach the handle assembly to the eyehole and use as a handle to raise and lower the jack.

A LIFTING

- Turn the handle counter-clockwise to lower the jack to its lowest position.
- Position the jack under the specified lift point.
- Begin lifting by turning the handle assembly clockwise.
- Ensure that the saddle is in the correct position and located under a vehicle manufacturer designated lifting point before vehicle contact has been made.
- Lift only to the point that the desired outcome can be reached. Do not over extend this jack.

- LOWERING
 - Turn the handle slowly counter-clockwise to lower the jack to its lowest position.
 - Do not get under or let anyone get under the vehicle while lowering.
 - Once completely lowered, remove the unit and return it back to its storage location.



la MAINTENANCE

Lubrication and Cleaning

Periodically clean and lubricate all moving parts and pivot points.

Damaged Equipment

Any jack that appears to be damaged in any way, is found to be worn, or operates abnormally SHALL BE REMOVED FROM SERVICE. It is recommended that in this event, the jack be replaced. No repairs are authorized and no parts are available for this jack.

Alterations

Because of potential hazards associated with this type of equipment, no alterations shall be made to the product.

Attachments and Adapters

There are no attachments or adapters available or authorized for use with this jack. Any use of attachments or adapters could result in property damage, injury or death.



INSPECTION

- Visual inspection shall be made before each use of the device by checking for abnormal conditions, such as cracked welds, leaks, and damaged, loose, or missing parts.
- Other inspections shall be made per product operating instructions.
- This device shall be inspected immediately if the device is believed to have been subjected to an abnormal load or shock. It is recommended that this inspection be made by a qualified service and repair facility.

This Jack should be stored in a dry location.




A TROUBLESHOOTING

Symptom	Possible Causes	Solu ti on
The jack will not lower completely.	1. The threads on the adjustment rod may be bent not allowing the jack to fully lower.	1. Transfer the weight to another jack and replace the jack.
Jack will not hold the load.	1. Overall damage to the jack.	1. Replace the jack.
Jack will not rise.	 Check to see if there is damage to the adjustment rod. Lubrication needed on moving components 	Replace the jack Lubricate moving parts and test function again.
Jack will not lift the load.	The weight of the unit being lifted is too high.	Decrease the weight of object being lifted or purchase a higher capacity jack.
Jack arm will not lower.	The threads on the adjustment rod may be bent not allowing the jack to fully lower.	1. Replace the jack.
