Operating Instructions

Plug the USB Type-C cable into any 5V DC power source and into the port on the wireless charging pad and let your wireless device fully charge until the indicator above the front LED turns green.

- Place your device on charging pad. Align the ⚡ symbol with the center of the pad. If the device is not in the correct position, the LED charging indicator will not light up.
- When your device is placed correctly on the charging pad and during charging, the LED charging indicator will light up red.
- When your device is fully charged on the charging pad, the LED charging indicator will light up green.
- When your device is left on the charging pad overnight, the LED charging indicator will remain green until your device is removed from the charging pad.
- Once your device is removed from the charging pad, the LED charging indicator will switch off.

Cautions

- DO NOT use in or around tubs, showers, sinks, pools, hot tubs or in any wet environment
- Use only the recommended voltage and frequency requirements
- Keep out of reach of children
- DO NOT operate light with wet hands
- Keep away from hot objects
- DO NOT leave light in direct sunlight for prolonged lengths of time
- DO NOT crush or expose to impact
- DO NOT disassemble or throw into fire or water to avoid causing a short circuit
- DO NOT use near magnetic bank cards or integrated chip (IC) cards to prevent card malfunction
